**Non-algebraic courses; not preparation for any algebraic course.**

<b>Course</b>	<b>Special guidance:</b>
<b>MAT 117</b>  <b>two levels of preparedness</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All students can take MAT 117, regardless of background, without prerequisite coursework.</li> <li>• Those who do not meet the prerequisite placement scores for MAT 117 may take the 4 day/week sections labeled MAT 117-C0y.</li> <li>• Although students who <i>already have</i> credit for a basic algebra course can directly register for MAT 117.</li> </ul> <p><i>MAT 117 is a prerequisite only to STA 125 and STA 135 (with a "C or better" in MAT 117) and for students MAT 115 or 215 and consent of instructor.</i></p>
<b>STA 125</b>  <b>three levels of preparedness</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students who <i>already have</i> credit for an Algebra course at or above the level of MAT096 (ie: MAT096, 097, 130, 140, 150) can directly register for STA 125.</li> <li>• Students who barely miss the prerequisites for STA 125 may take the 4 day/week sections labeled STA 125-C0y.</li> <li>• Students who do not place into STA 125-C0y can take MAT 117-C0y, and <i>then take</i> STA 125 (if they've earned a "C or better" in MAT 117-C0y).</li> </ul> <p>STA 125 is not a prerequisite to any other course.</p>
<b>STA 135</b>  <b>three levels of preparedness</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students who have credit for an Algebra course at or above the level of MAT097 (ie: MAT097, 130, 140, 150) can directly register for STA 135.</li> <li>• Students who barely miss the prerequisites for STA 135 may take the 5 day/week sections labeled STA 135-C0y.</li> <li>• Students who do not place into STA 135-C0y can take MAT 117-C0y, and then STA 135 (after they've earned a "C or better" in MAT 117-C0y).</li> </ul>

**Entry-level algebraic courses; typically not needed for preparation for non-algebraic course.**

<b>Course</b>	<b>Special guidance:</b>
<b>MAT 110</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This course is <b>only</b> for students whose program               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• requires any of MAT 130 or 140 or 145, or 150, or 220 or 230 or 250</li> <li>• and whose level of preparedness does not place them into MAT 140-C2y.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• All such students can take MAT 110, regardless of prerequisite coursework, as long as their placement scores do not already place them into one of the courses listed in the bullet above.</li> <li>• Students needing MAT 130 or 150, but who must take MAT 110, will replace MAT 130 or 150 by MAT 140+MAT 145.</li> <li>• It is not needed for any program using <i>only</i> courses from MAT 117, STA 125, 135.</li> <li>• It is not a University Studies course.</li> </ul>
<b>MAT 140</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students who have credit for an equivalent of MAT097 can register for MAT 140.</li> <li>• Students who have credit for an equivalent of MAT096 can register for the 5 day/week sections labeled MAT 140-Cxy.</li> <li>• Students who barely miss the prerequisites for MAT 140 may take the 5 day/week sections labeled MAT 140-C2y.</li> <li>• Students who do not place into MAT 140-C2y can take MAT 110, and with a "C or better" in MAT 110, can register for the 5 day/week sections labeled MAT 140-C2y in the next semester.</li> </ul>
<b>MAT 130</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students who have credit for an Algebra course at or above the level of MAT097 or who have a sufficient placement score can directly register for MAT 130.</li> <li>• Students who do not meet the prerequisites for MAT130 may replace MAT130 by MAT140 (via a MAT 140-C section) and then MAT145. Follow the entry advice for MAT 140.</li> </ul>
<b>MAT 145</b>	<p>Students can register for MAT 145 with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• appropriate placement scores</li> <li>• A "C or better" in MAT097 or MAT 140</li> </ul>
<b>MAT 150</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students who do not meet the prerequisites for MAT 150 may replace MAT 150 by MAT 140 and MAT 145. Follow the entry advice for MAT 140.</li> </ul>
